Mass Gathering Permits were discussed regarding Insurance requirements while serving Alcohol as brought up by audience member Carole Osterink. Ms. Osterink questioned this pertaining to an Historic Hudson event recently held at the Dunn Warehouse for their annual meeting. She also brought up that our "one size fits all" Insurance requirement should be reviewed.

Alderman Friedman suggested we visit with Insurance Brokers regarding mass gathering permits when Alcohol is involved. The committee agreed.











Mayor Tiffany Martin Hamilton,
