- Suggest to the Mayor that both her office and the office of the

  to offer a greater power and additional flexibility with all Mid-Hudson negotiations.
- Enter into a one year contract with Mid-Hudson Cable with a 14 year to year renewal clause.
- Establish a "blue ribbon" committee (non political) that would review all data being utilized by the city, residents and businesses. This would include broadband, cable, telephone, etc.
