A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO OBTAIN APPRAISALS ON REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson and the County of Columbia have expressed an interest in conducting a feasibility study regarding the benefit to both municipal entities of collectively moving their offices to the John L. Edwards School; and

WHEREAS, the consolidation of City and County operations in a single building may provide a benefit to both municipal entities and to taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, determining the square footage and fair market value of the Hudson City Hall, Hudson Youth Department Building and Hudson Day Care Center will be an important factor in the feasibility analysis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Hudson hereby authorizes the Mayor the City of Hudson to obtain appraisals, at a cost not to exceed \$4,000.00, for the Hudson City Hall, Hudson Youth Department Building and Hudson Day Care Center to determine the square footage and fair market value of said buildings and to share the results of same with the Common Council, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to make the following transfer:
