**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY OF COLUMBIA
ENGAGE IN FEASIBILITY STUDY WITH THE CITY OF HUDSON
ON THE ACQUISITION AND USE OF THE JOHN L. EDWARDS
SCHOOL FOR CITY/COUNTY MUNICIPAL OFFICES**

WHEREAS, the Hudson City School District is in the process of closing the John L. Edwards School; and

WHEREAS, the John L. Edwards School is centrally located within the City of Hudson ("City") and may provide an advantageous location for the offices of the City of Hudson; and

WHEREAS, the County of Columbia ("County") has likewise expressed an interest in moving certain County offices to the John L. Edwards School; and

WHEREAS, the consolidation of City and County operations in a single building may provide a benefit to both municipal entities and to taxpayers; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Hudson hereby requests that the County of Columbia engage in feasibility study with the City of Hudson on the acquisition and use of the John L. Edwards School for city/county municipal offices.
