Where two or more responsible bidders submit identical bids as to price, the City of Hudson may award the Contract to either bidder. The City of Hudson may waive any formalities or reject any and all bids and re-advertise for new bids at its discretion.

No bid may be withdrawn by any bidder for a period of 45 days from the date of bid opening. **BID PRICE SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED FOR 45 DAYS FROM DATE OF BID OPENING.**

PRICE: Price shall be net and shall include delivery of item to the City of Hudson Department of Youth, 18 South Third Street.
