PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING

The City of Hudson Department of Public Works has announced that a Public Informational Meeting will be held to discuss the proposed **Reconstruction of the Ferry Street Bridge over CSX/Amtrak, PIN 8761.55**. The meeting will be held at the Hudson Area Library, 51 N. 5th St, Hudson, NY 12534 on Monday October 29, 2018 from 6:30 to 7:30 pm.

The City, in cooperation with the New York State Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration, is developing design studies for the proposed replacement of the Ferry Street Bridge over CSX/Amtrak. The project will begin at the boat launch parking lot to west of the bridge, extend across the existing structure, and terminate at the intersection of Ferry Street and South Front Street.

The purpose of the meeting is to obtain comments on the proposed project from individuals, groups, officials and local agencies. The City is specifically soliciting comments on the development of alternates for the project and comments on the project's social, economic and environmental effects. This public informational meeting is part of the continuing efforts by the City, the New York State Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration to encourage public input into the development of transportation projects.

On display for open discussion, will be plans and details of the proposed bridge reconstruction along with associated roadway approach reconstruction. At 6:30 pm there will be a brief presentation that will provide an overview of the proposed bridge details, construction schedule and cost.
